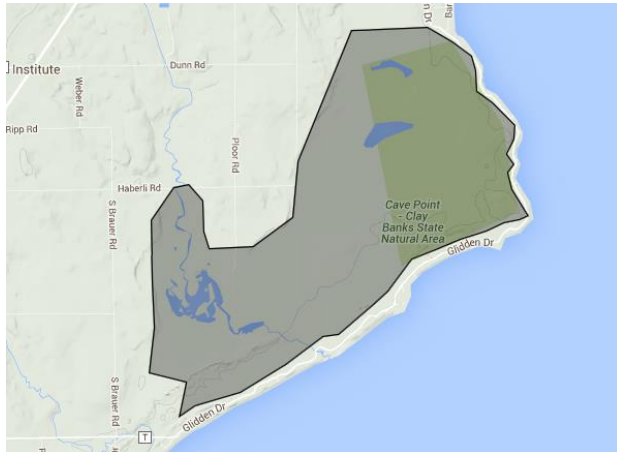


Ridge and Swale Communities:

Only one project has significant acres left to protect.

Shivering Sands, Door County: Shivering Sands encompasses many geologic and natural elements to form a contiguous and complex landscape. Large tracts of lowland coniferous forest grade to upland stands of mixed northern hardwood/conifer forest. The lake-edge fen communities harbor the state-threatened coast sedge and a breeding population of the Hine's Emerald. Numerous springs emanate from the dolomite bedrock.



- Wisconsin Responsibility – High
- Irreplaceable Features – Moderately High
- Diversity of Natural Features – Moderate
- Rare Species – Moderately High
- Species of Conservation Concern – Moderately High
- Vulnerability to a Warming Climate – High
- Conservation Status – Half

This site has narrow conservation opportunities.

Most ridge and swale communities have seen intensive past protection efforts. Small acres of additional work are needed to complete acquisition for these properties:
