

Niagara Escarpment Communities:

Red Banks Alvar in Brown County: This largest and most in need of site conservation is presented on the Lake Michigan page.

Midsized Niagara Escarpment Projects: The next site has known quality escarpment forest.

Stockbridge Ledge SNA, Calumet: Stockbridge Ledge Woods features a mature forest situated on the top of the Niagara Escarpment. The forest is dominated by large sugar maple, American beech, and basswood along with white oak and contains numerous savanna grasses and forbs. Ephemeral ponds are present throughout the flat crest of the outcrop.

This site has narrow conservation opportunities.

Existing Protected Areas for Fen, Prairie, Savanna and Bog Relict:

These sites are almost entirely in public ownership with a few parcels left to complete protection.

- Rock Island State Park – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- Death Door County Park – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- Ellison Bluff County Park – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- Boyer’s Bluff – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- Peninsula State Park – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- Potawatomi State Park – Cliffs along Green Bay.
- High Cliff State Park – Cliffs along Lake Winnebago.
- Bayshore Blufflands SNA, Door County – Some protection has occurred, but much remains to be protected in this high value development area.
- Ledge Bar, Fond du Lac County - A small ledge with rare snails in northern Fond du Lac County in private ownership.

- Greenleaf Escarpment, Brown County – This site has the entire bluff top developed. Residents should be made aware that lawn management activities probably will harm rare snails.
- Oakfield Ledge SNA, Fond du Lac County – About ½ of the ledge has been protected.
- Mayville Ledge SNA, Dodge County –Protected as a State Natural Area
- Ledge Park, Dodge County – The site is protected as a county park.
